

Medication Side Effects

Your doctor has recommended medication to help you get better. Many medications can cause **side effects** (unplanned reactions in the body).

The table below lists medication names next to their side effects. If you have any of the serious side effects listed for your medication, contact your doctor or call 911 right away (see box at right).

Other serious side effects are also possible. If you have symptoms not listed here or any concerns about your medications, talk to your medical team.

NOTE: All medications have the potential to cause an allergic reaction. **Call 911 or go to the nearest emergency treatment facility if you have:**

- Difficulty breathing
- Trouble seeing
- Uncontrolled bleeding
- Swelling of the mouth, tongue, or face
- Confusion
- Dizziness, lack of coordination or balance
- Sudden weakness or numbness on the face, arm, or leg, especially if on one side of the body

Call your doctor right away if you have any other serious side effects listed with your medication.

Improve breathing (inhalers)	 albuterol (ProAir, Proventil, Ventolin) beclomethasone (Qvar) budesonide / formoterol (Symbicort) fluticasone/salmeterol (Advair, AirDuo) tiotropium (Spiriva) 	Dry mouth, restlessness Beclomethasone, budesonide/ formoterol, and fluticasone/salmeterol: Yeast infection in mouth/throat (thrush)	albuterol: Shaking in arms or legs, increased or irregular heart rate
Sleep aid	 quetiapine (Seroquel) trazodone zolpidem (Ambien)	Headache, dizziness, nausea	Seeing things that aren't there, chest pains, confusion, memory loss
Ulcer prevention (control stomach acid or bleeding)	famotidine (Pepcid)omeprazole (Prilosec)pantoprazole (Protonix)	Headache, nausea, diarrhea
