WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:

- Insurance card
- Photo ID
- Clothes and any personal items for yourself and your child
- Money for food or other items
- Information on your child's health history
- Leave valuables at home but feel free to bring items that can help comfort your child
- Please bring a list of medication your child is currently taking. The hospital is unable to use any home medications and the pharmacy will dispense additional doses while you are in the hospital.

WHAT THE HOSPITAL CAN PROVIDE:

- Hospital PJs
 - Hygiene items, including diapers and bathing supplies.
- If using diapers larger than size 5, please bring a few for

your child until we can stock your child's size.

- For breast-feeding mothers, a pump room and refrigerator are available. Please bring your pump kit.

If, for any reason, your arrival time differs from the time indicated above, please call (801) 285-2470 to update hospital staff.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE TO THE HOSPITAL:

Please check in at the main admitting, or proceed directly to the unit, depending on the time of arrival. The main admitting office is located down the left hall on your right once you enter through the Main Entrance on the first floor. The unit is on the 4th floor on the south end of the hospital.

REGISTRATION TIMES:

Main admitting office (day time hours) Monday - Friday 6 AM - 6 PM; Saturday 8 - 12 PM

If main admitting is closed, go directly to the 4th floor Children's Unit.

After being admitted, you will receive a map to the unit and room you have been assigned. Take the admit papers to your room and give them to the nurse. The care team will be anticipating your arrival.
