Free community health fair on June 20 featuring free screenings, health information and lots of fun!

In fact, to show our appreciation for the community's support, we're hosting a **free community health fair in Riverton Hospital's west parking lot on Saturday, June 20, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.**

Everyone is invited and all events are free. You'll be able to take advantage of free screenings, health information, updates on the new hospital and Primary Children's outpatient services, and an opportunity to visit with physicians that will be located on the campus. Plus, it will be a lot of fun. Bring the kids and enjoy the activities at the fair including:

- Free cholesterol, glucose, and vision screenings
- Free blood pressure checks
- Information about Riverton Hospital and Primary Children's Outpatient Services, opening November 2009 (You'll have to wait until October to take a tour of the hospital).
- Information on breast cancer detection and mammography
- Information on emergency preparedness and injury prevention
- Childhood immunizations from Immunization Express – *Cost: \$10 if you qualify for Vaccines for Children federal guidelines. If insured, Immunization Express may have the ability to bill your insurance.*
- Bicycle safety rodeo sponsored by the Salt Lake City Bicycle Collective – Be sure to bring your bike or scooter to ride through the course. And don't forget your helmet!
- Health care mural for kids to color
- Primary Children's injury prevention information and displays on safety in and around cars and water

- Get a close up look at one of our Intermountain Life Flight helicopters, Gold Cross ambulances, and Salt Lake County Sheriff's police and fire vehicles
