## MULTIDISCIPLINARY LIMB PRESERVATION PROGRAM

The Intermountain Limb Preservation Program was established to help patients with injuries and diseases that place their limbs at risk, such as non-healing fractures, infections of bone and metal implants, and all tumors of muscles and bones, including sarcomas.

Our consultants are experts in treating rare cancers, osteomyelitis and other diseases of bones, joints and muscles. They are committed to giving you the most advanced and compassionate care possible with the goal of maximizing your overall function and preserving limb use. Depending on your needs and wishes, our consultants can assume primary care of the condition or they can simply provide you with a second opinion.

To better treat these difficult problems, our consultants have sub-specialty training in orthopedic trauma, musculoskeletal oncology, plastic surgery, infectious disease, pathology, radiation oncology and medical oncology. On the Intermountain Medical Center campus, we have access to wound care specialists, hyperbaric oxygen chambers, physical and occupational therapy, video-

conferencing and the most advanced imaging and radiation treatment equipment available.

**Steven Scott, MD, Program Director**, is a fellowship-trained sarcoma and musculoskeletal tumor surgeon. He is board certified and limits his practice to limb-preservation techniques and to the care of these rare and difficult tumors. He is a member of the Musculoskeletal Tumor Society and the Ivins Society, two subspecialty groups dedicated to the care of these diseases. Dr. Scott is well-published in musculoskeletal research and in the surgical management of these tumors. He has been named by peers as “One of the Best Doctors in America.”

### SOME OF THE MEDICAL CONDITIONS THE PROGRAM ADDRESSES:

- Bone and muscle tumors of the limbs, trunk and spine, including sarcomas
- Orthopedic infections/osteomyelitis
- Non-unions/non-healing fractures
- Osteonecrosis
- Limb deformities and shortening
- Infected metal implants and artificial joints
- Stable trauma (mangled extremities)
- Amputation reconstruction and revision

*During your visit you may also meet with other specialists, including:*

- Plastic surgeon
- Infectious disease specialist
- Physical or occupational therapist
- Lymphedema specialist
- Wound care specialist
- Radiation oncologist
- Medical oncologist
- Financial counseling
- Other imaging studies may be scheduled as needed
