What is the Jubilee of Trees?	Jubilee of Trees is an annual fundraising event hosted by Intermountain Foundation, a 501(c)3, non-profit organization benefitting St. George Regional Hospital. For over 40 years, this beloved holiday event has united the southern Utah community in supporting critical healthcare services like pediatric cancer, Life Flight, heart services, and advancing children's health in the community. This year, our eye is set on Oncology and supporting a future where no cancer is untreatable.		
Why become a designer?	Make a difference and create lasting impact! Becoming a designer is a powerful and meaningful way to contribute to the cause, whether you're honoring a loved one, showing appreciation for the care you or your loved ones received at St. George Regional Hospital, or making a personal impact because you or someone you know has been affected by cancer. Your donated items enhance the Jubilee's magic, attract bids, and raise funds to support a future where no cancer is untreatable in our southern Utah community.		
Who can become a designer?	Anyone! We welcome anyone individuals, families, businesses, business owners, school clubs, church groups, community groups, etc.		
Can I build a design team?	Absolutely! We encourage you to build a team and involve friends and family. Collaborating with loved ones can make the experience even more enjoyable and fulfilling. Bringing together a team to create your design amplifies its impact and embodies the magic of the event by fostering a sense of community and collective giving.		
What items can I design and donate?	 Designer Trees 7ft - 10ft Enchanted Forest Trees 4ft - 6ft Mini Trees 18inches - 3ft Wreaths minimum diameter must be 24 inches Gingerbread Houses 		
What is the minimum required monetary value for design items donated?	 Designer Trees - \$1,500 Enchanted Forest Trees - \$400 Mini Trees & Wreaths - \$150 Gingerbread Houses - \$75 Minimum \$ amounts designers are expected to invest in their donated item. 		
Are there costs involved in being a designer, and what is a Gift-In-Kind donation?	Yes, designers are responsible for the monetary costs for their designed items, which are then received by Intermountain Foundation as a generous gift-in-kind donation. These non-cash donations of goods or services (i.e. trees, wreaths, gingerbread houses) are tax-deductible. Your design donations are invaluable in enhancing the Jubilee's magic, attracting bids, and raising funds to support a future where no cancer in untreatable in our southern Utah community.

Who attends the Jubilee of Trees event?	Jubilee of Trees attracts thousands of visitors and is open to the public, where individuals and families are invited to join in an open-house style event. Your donation will be showcased to a wide audience, including community members, local businesses, Gala and event attendees.		
How are donated design items auctioned off?	Designer and Enchanted Forest Trees will be part of a silent auction, where attendees can bid on their favorites, with the highest bids winning the items, while Mini Trees, Wreaths, and Gingerbread Houses will be available for in-person purchase throughout the event.		
What is the time commitment expected to be a designer?	There are two mandatory Designer Meetings you or a member of your design team will need to attend on Saturday, September 7 and Saturday, October 26 (see designer information packet). Designer Setup/Drop-off Day Tuesday, November, 19 from 9 am to 9 pm. • Designer & Enchanted Forest Trees must arrive 50% pre-assembled. • Mini Trees, Wreaths, & Gingerbread Houses must arrive 100% assembled.		
What support is available to me as a designer?	Designers receive guidance and support from our Jubilee volunteer Committee Intermountain Foundation Event Specialist.
