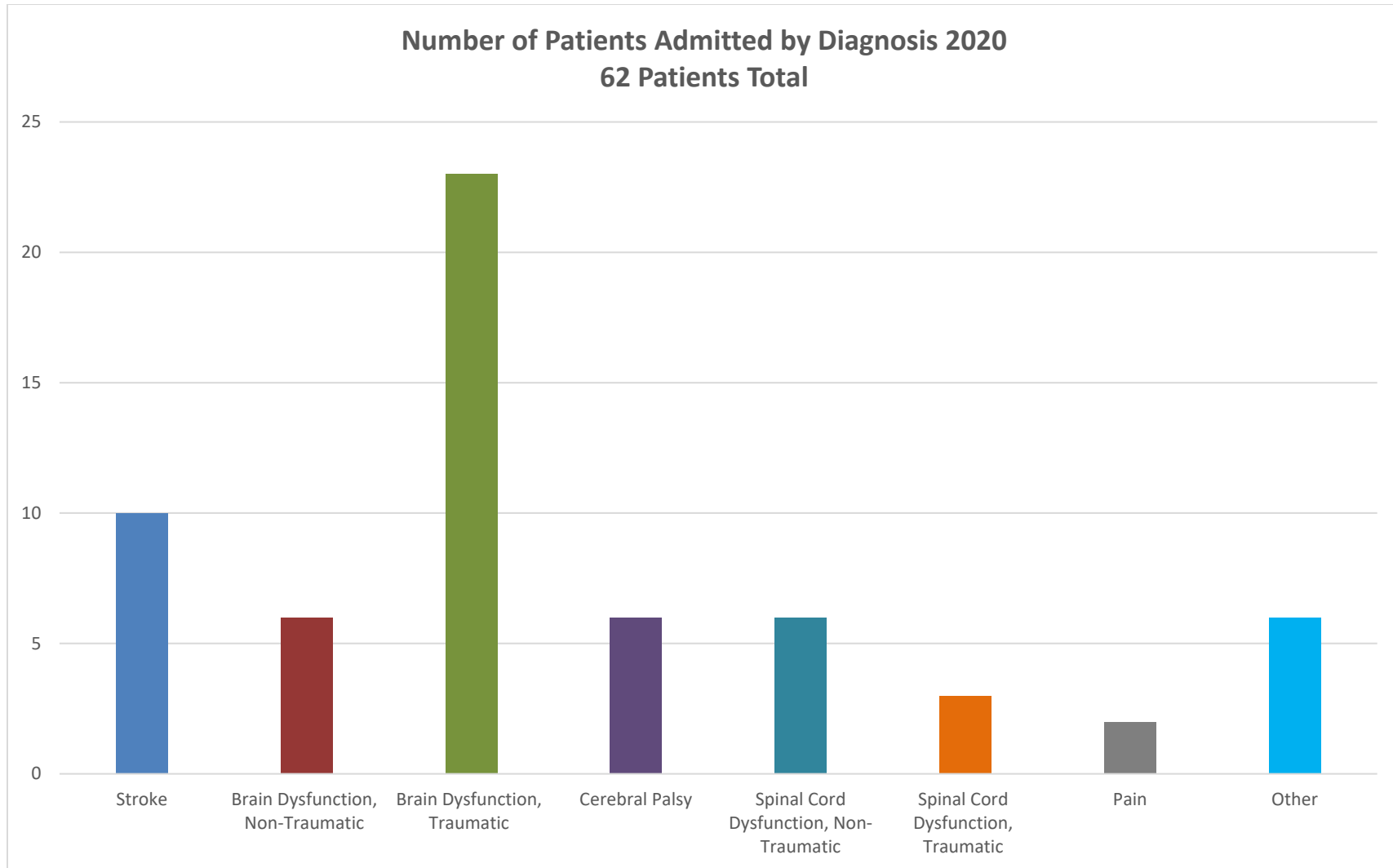

Average Therapy Hours per Day: 3.6 hours/day

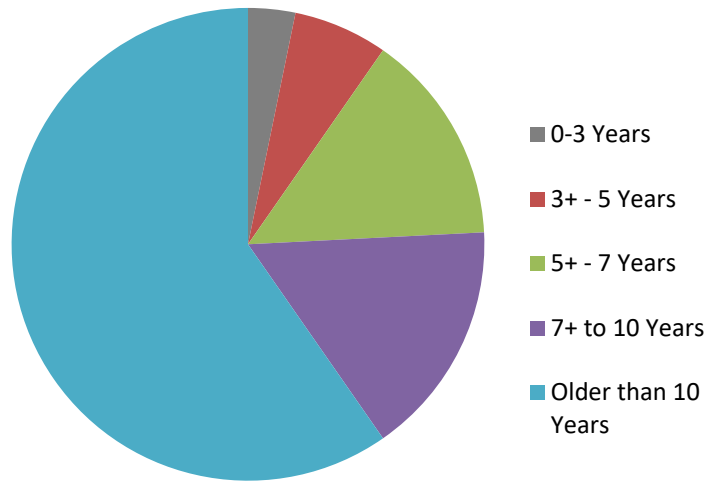

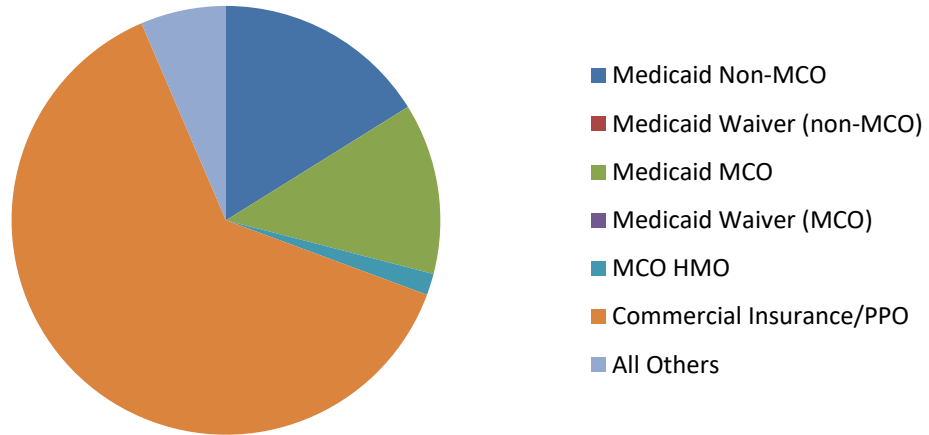

## Ages of Patients Admitted 2020



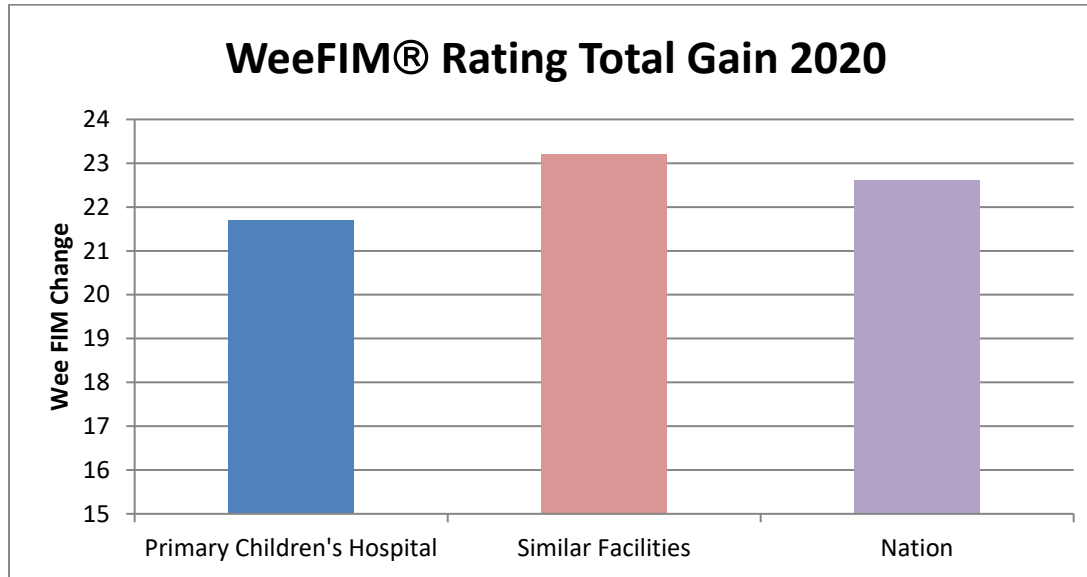
We accept children, adolescents, and young adults ages 7 months – 21+ years of age

## Payer Mix for Admissions 2020



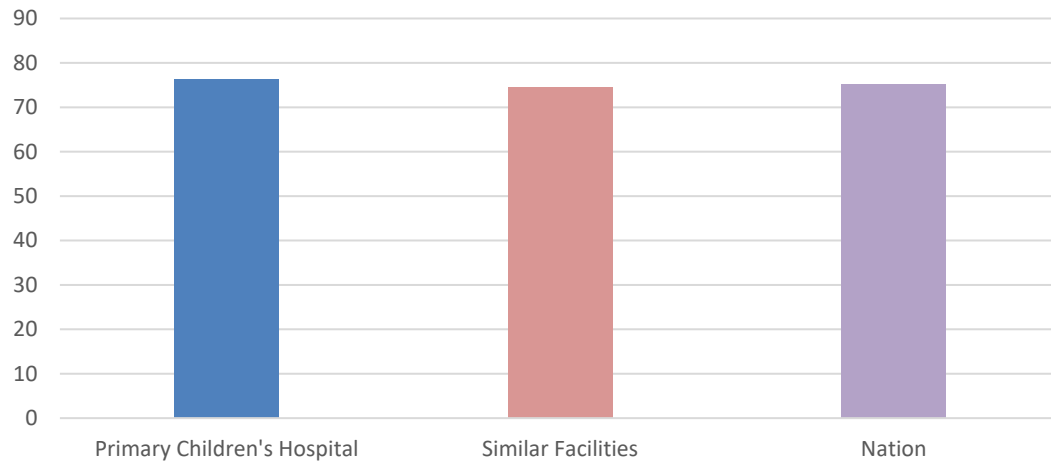
We work with all third-party payers

The WeeFIM II® System (Functional Independence Measure for Children) is a nationally recognized tool that records the progress made by the child/adolescent. It is the most respected pediatric outcomes management tool in the market, measuring skills related to Eating, Dressing, Bathing, Bowel/Bladder, Toileting, Mobility, and Cognition. We analyze the data obtained to help us improve our program and benchmark against other inpatient rehabilitation programs.



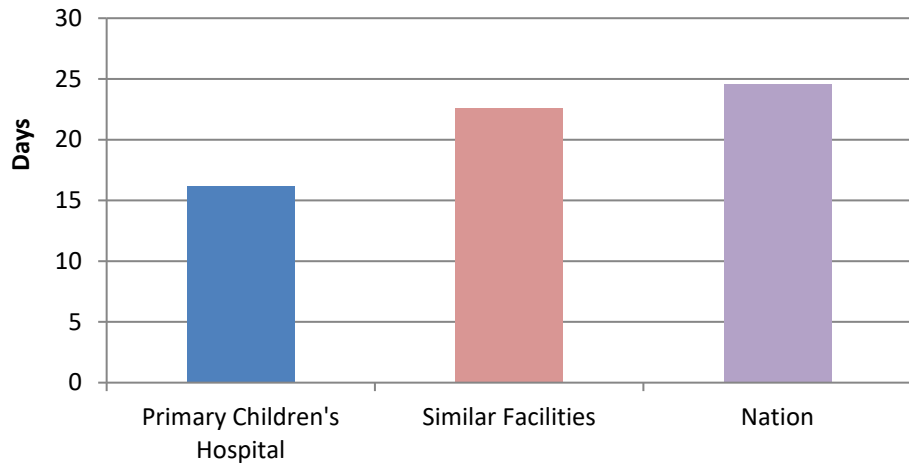
The functional improvement our children make while in our program is greater than the comparison facilities.

## Discharge WeeFIM® Rating Total 2020



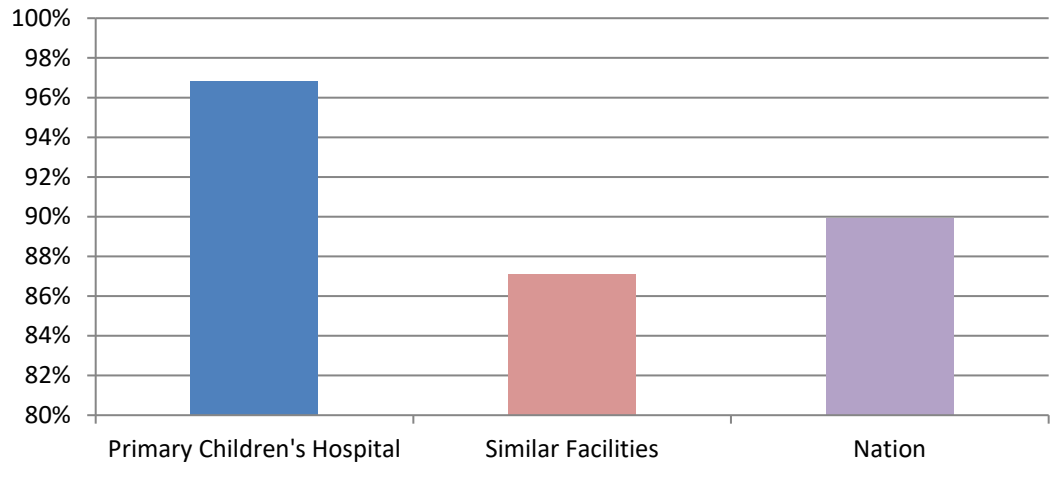
We discharge patients home sooner and at a higher functional level than other programs.

Our goal is to get children home as quickly as is safely possible. Children/Adolescents spend less time in our program while still making excellent functional gains.

Our goal is to have children return to their home and communities following discharge from our program. While other programs discharge fewer than 90% of their patients to home, in 2020, 97% of our patients went home after graduating from our program.
