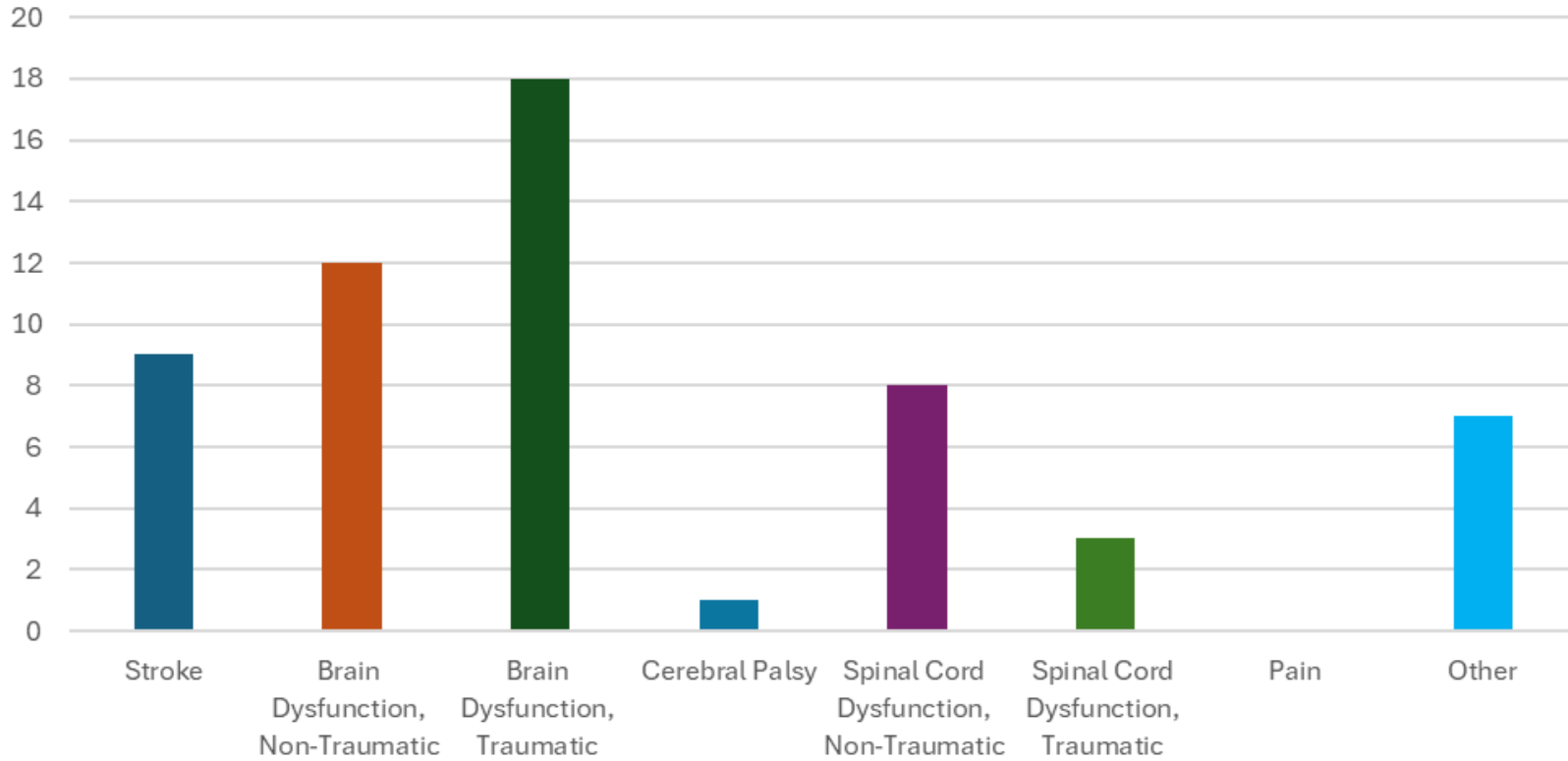


Primary Children's Hospital Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation Program provides extraordinary care to those we serve.

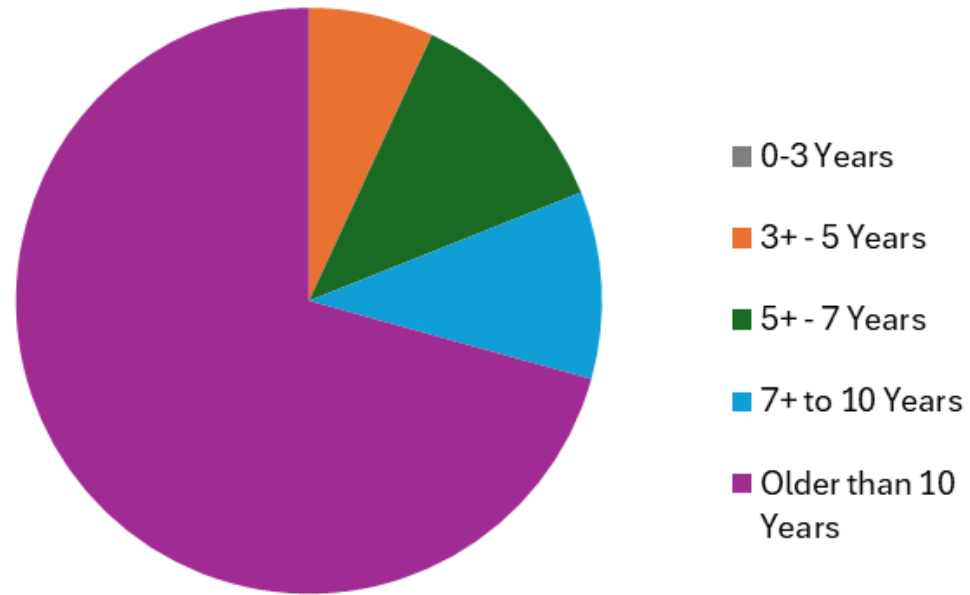
Number of Patients Admitted by Diagnosis 2023



We accept children, adolescents, and young adults ages 7 months – 21+ years of age

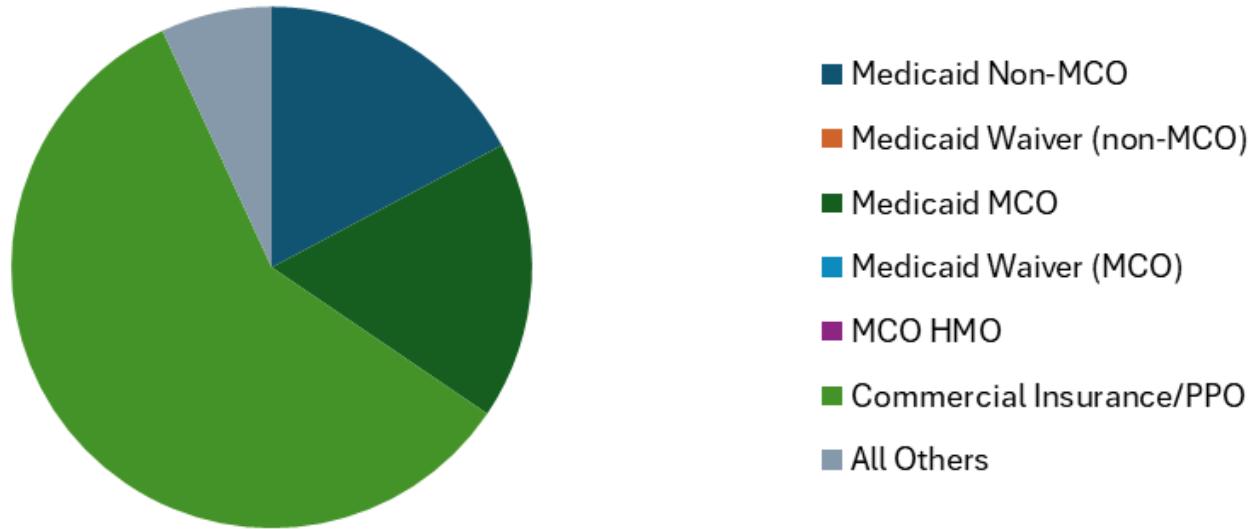

Payer Mix for Admissions 2023

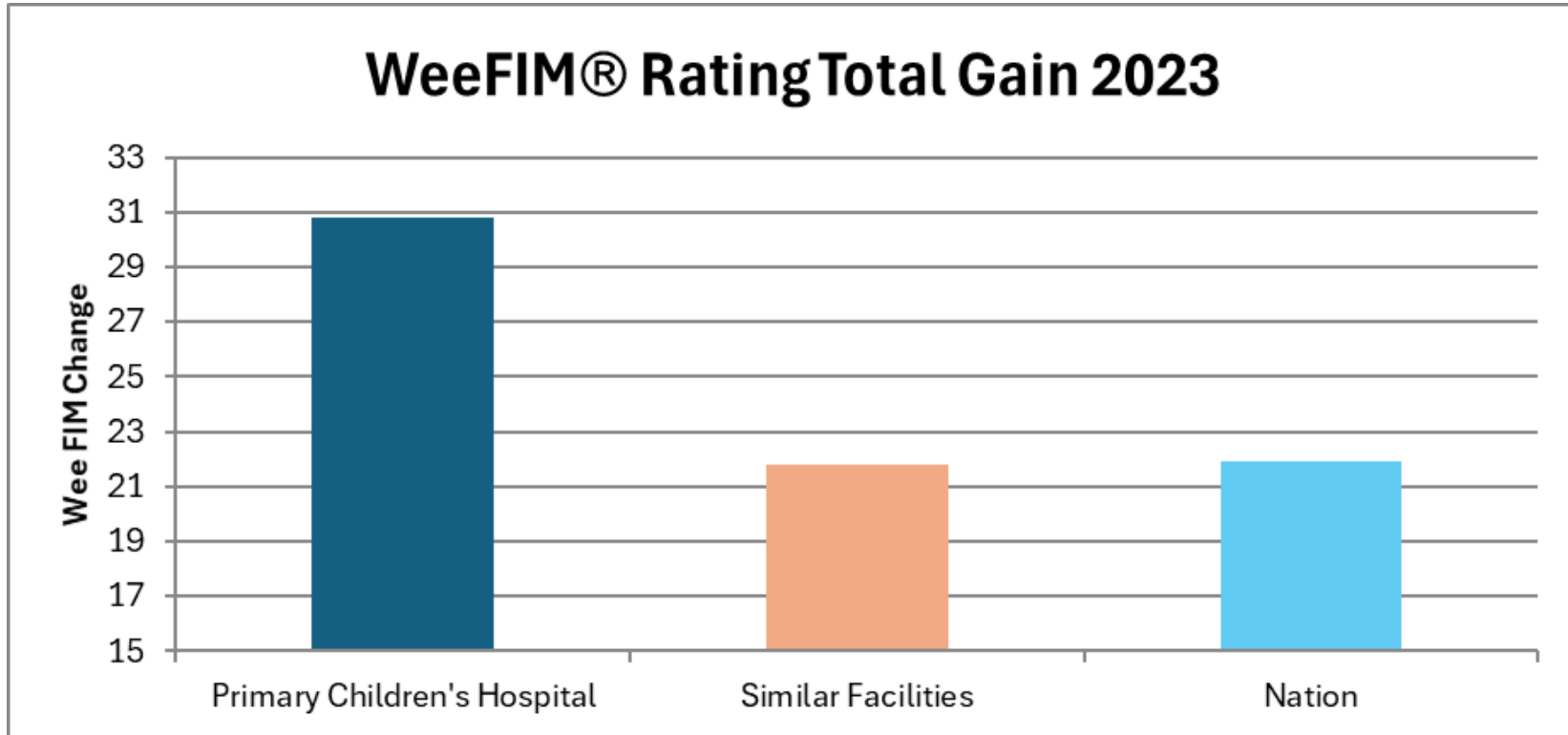

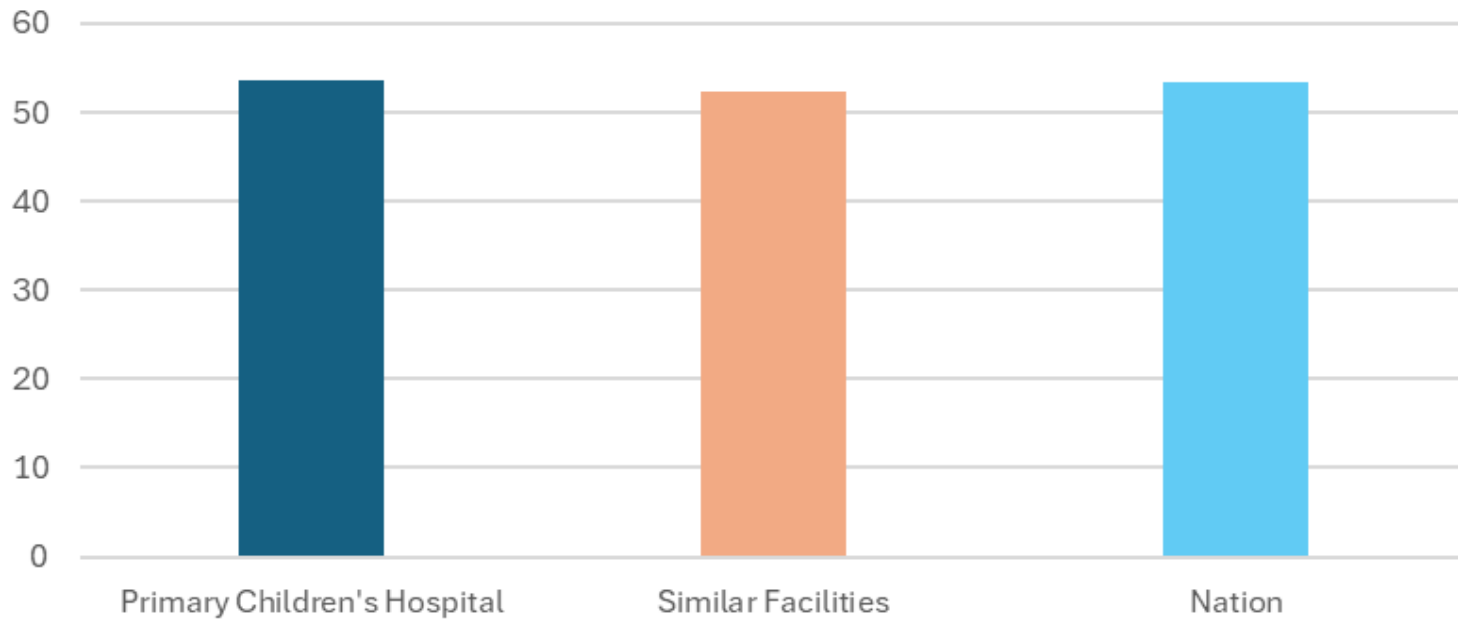
The WeeFIM II® System (Functional Independence Measure for Children) is a nationally recognized tool that records the progress made by the child/adolescent. It is the most respected pediatric outcomes management tool in the market,

measuring skills related to Eating, Dressing, Bathing, Bowel/Bladder, Toileting, Mobility, and Cognition. We analyze the data obtained to help us improve our program and benchmark against other inpatient rehabilitation programs.

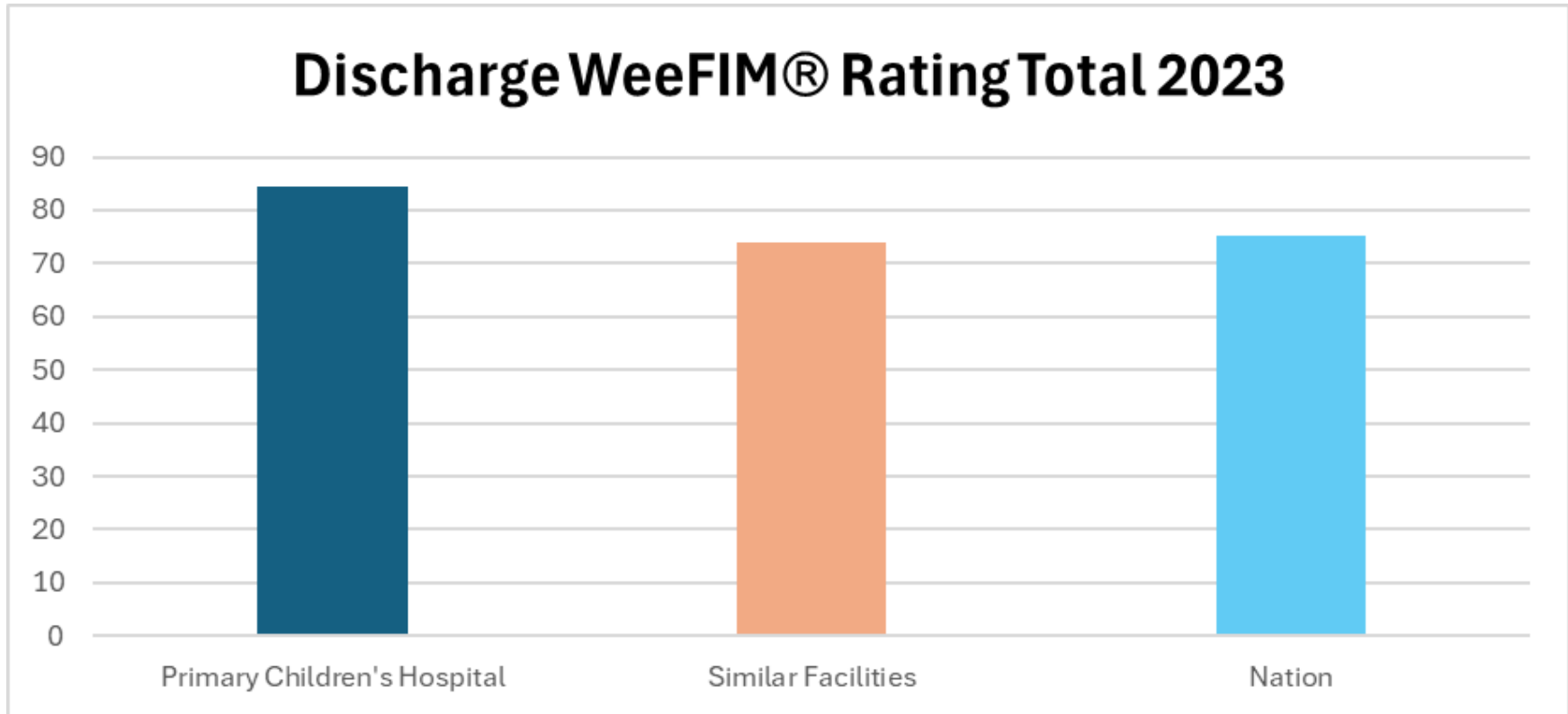


The functional improvement our children make while in our program is greater than the comparison facilities.

Admission WeeFIM® Rating Total 2023



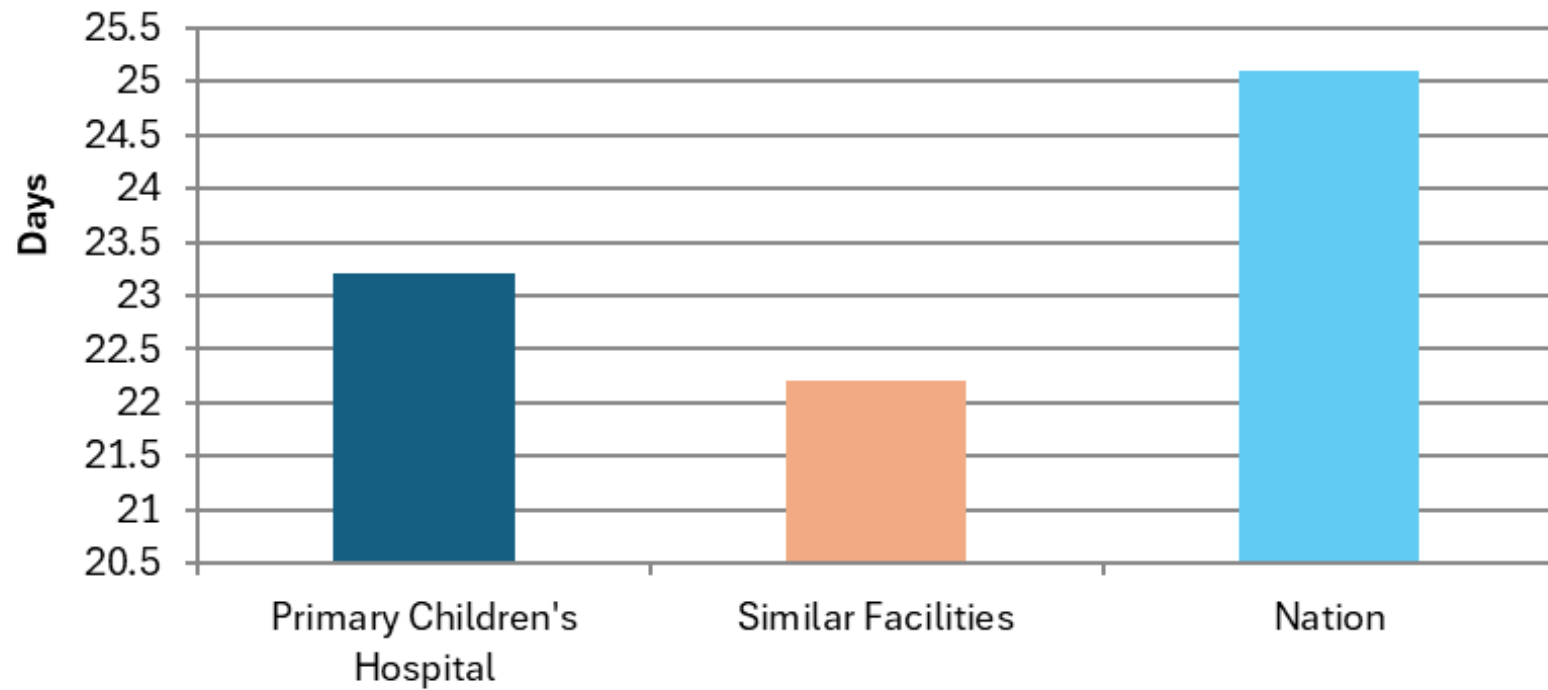
Discharge WeeFIM® Rating Total 2023



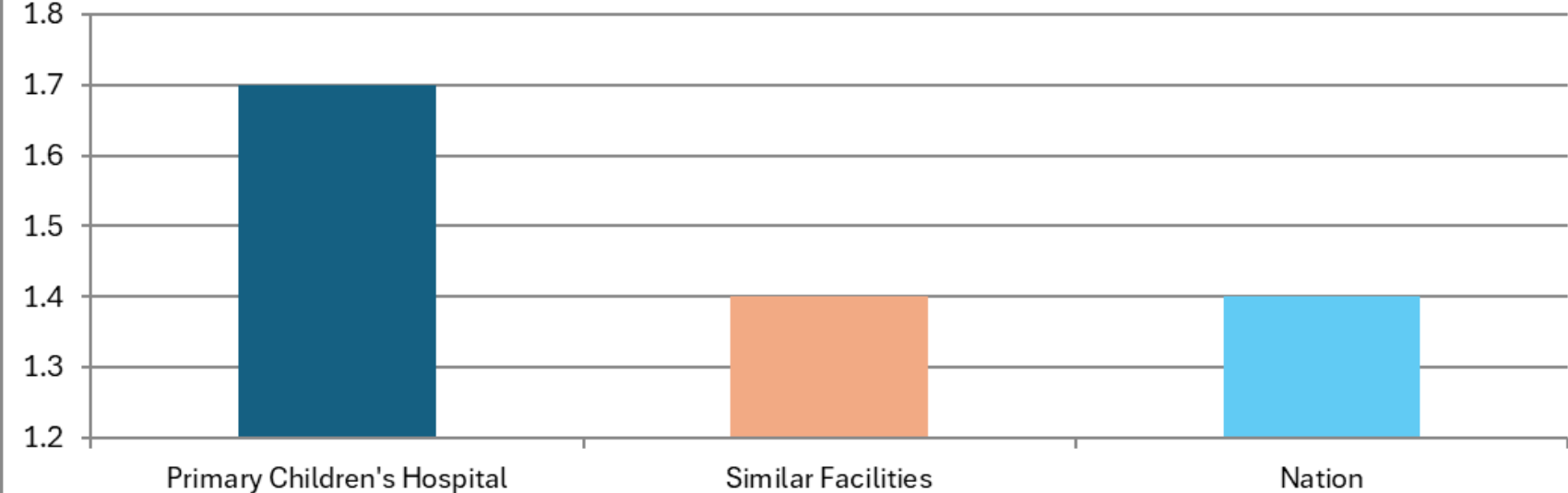
Our goal is to get children home as quickly as is safely possible.

Children/Adolescents spend less time in our program while still making excellent functional gains.

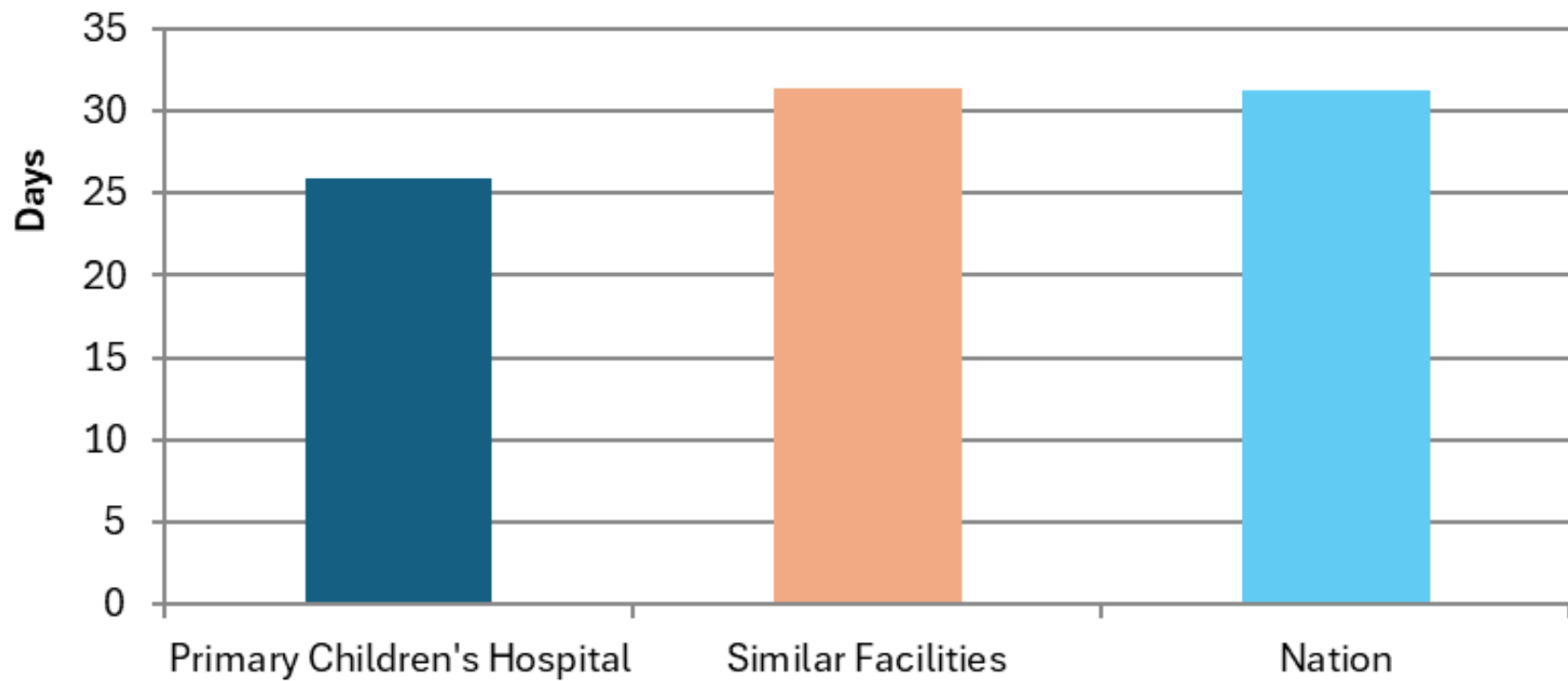
Average Length of Stay 2023



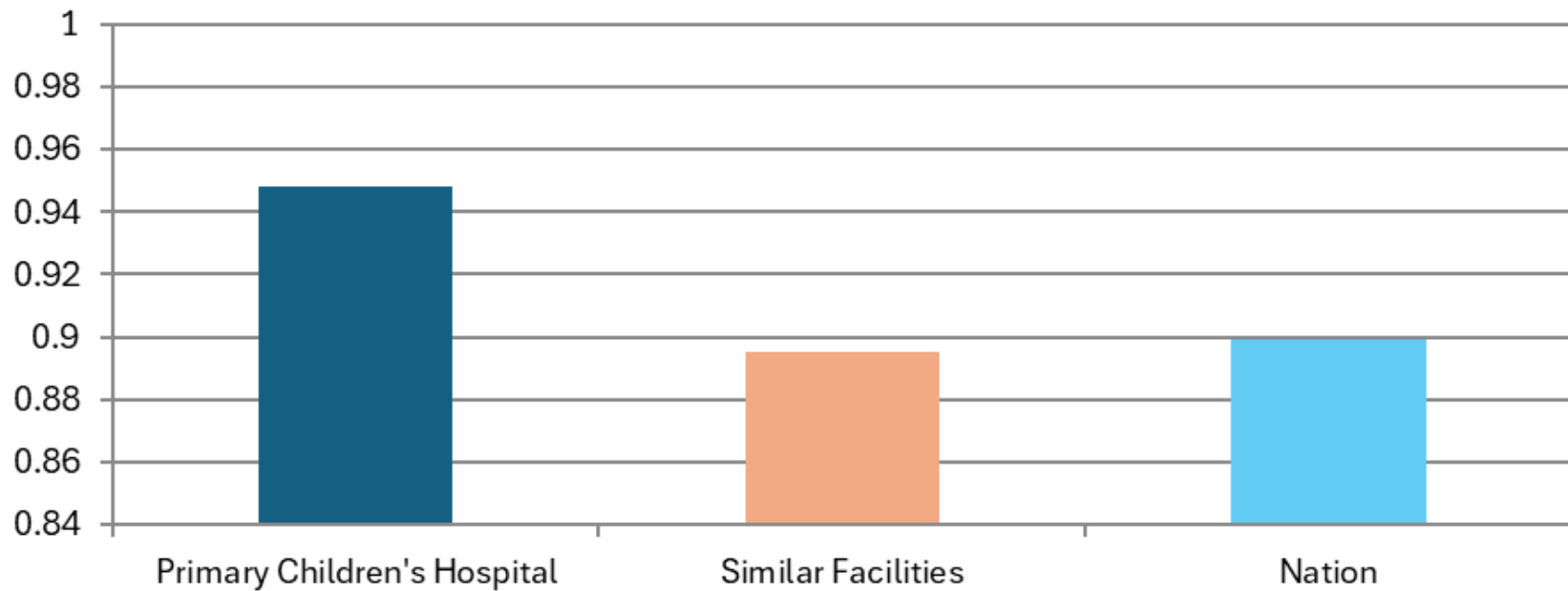
Length of Stay Efficiency 2023
