

# Intermountain Sanpete Valley Hospital Scholarship

In an on-going effort to support the students in our communities, Sanpete Valley Hospital is proud to announce the annual Sanpete Valley Hospital Scholarship program. This program will donate two \$1,000 scholarship awards to high school seniors in Sanpete County.

## To be considered, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Currently a High School Senior at a Sanpete County High School, or participating in an accredited HS curriculum and residing in Sanpete County
- Hold a Current GPA of 3.5 or Higher
- Be Actively Involved in Community Service

## **Application Process**

Applications may be obtained at sanpetehospital.org or from high school counselors. **Completed applications, along with resume, and a 300-500 word essay** <u>must be scanned and emailed to</u> <u>shauna.watts@imail.org or to your school counselor by Thursday, April 25, 2024</u>. The essay should provide details on the student's experience with community service as well as plans for pursuing their chosen career, and how they would use the scholarship award if selected.

#### Selection

Representatives from a selected board will review the applicants and select two students to receive the \$1,000 scholarship awards. Selection will be based on the student's application, resume, and essay.

## **Award Process**

Scholarship recipients will need to provide proof of registration to an accredited college of their choice to Sanpete Valley Hospital and complete applicable tax forms in order to receive the award. Sanpete Valley Hospital will then make the \$1,000 donation towards the student's tuition or other schooling expenses (please allow for at least four weeks processing time from when the forms are submitted to the time that the award check is received). Scholarship awards will be held for **up to three years** for those recipient(s) who will not be attending college for the following school year(s).
