INTRODUCTION

Adolescents and young adults (AYAs) are patients between the ages of 15-39 who have been diagnosed with cancer. A cancer diagnosis presents different challenges for teens and young adults than for younger children or older adults. Cancer can disrupt big milestones that commonly happen during this age range, like completing school, choosing a career path, building personal relationships, raising a family, and working toward emotional, social, and financial independence.


