

## Standardized Uniform/Scrub Color Assignment

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### Caregiver Role

- RN (all departments).....Navy Blue
- Participating physician / LIP ..... Light blue or Green
- LPN ..... White Top / Navy Blue Bottom
- CNA/PCT ..... Light Gray
- Nursing Supervisor .....Navy Blue with a White Lab Coat
- Imaging Technician.....Dark Gray
- Imaging Assistant Aide ..... Light Gray
- Phlebotomist ..... Khaki
- CV Technician .....Dark Gray
- EKG Tech..... Light Gray
- Hemodialysis Tech.....Tan
- Staff in Surgical or Procedural Areas..... Operating Room Green
- Transporter/Other Assistive Role ..... Light Gray
- Medical Assistance ..... Dark Gray and Turquoise
- Respiratory Therapy ..... Dark Green
- Inpatient Physical Therapy ..... Olive
- Inpatient Occupational Therapy ..... Caribbean Blue
- Inpatient Speech Pathologist ..... Olive
- Dental Assistants ..... Dark Gray and Turquoise

### Child-friendly Scrub Tops

- Pediatrics and NICU staff are allowed to wear child-friendly scrub tops. T-shirts, sweat shirts, hoodies, and golf shirts are not allowed.
- Scrub bottoms are to be the assigned solid color.

#### Allowed designs:

- Animals, insects, birds
- Super-hero characters
- Cartoon characters
- Infant symbols (blocks, alphabet letters, etc.)
- Sports symbols (bats, mitts, soccer balls, etc.)
- Automobiles (cars, trucks, fire trucks, bulldozers, etc.)

#### Excluded designs:

- Weapons
  - Gang symbols
  - Racial symbols
  - Religious symbols
  - Hate symbols
  - Sexually suggestive characters or symbols
  - Messages (inspirational or non-inspirational)
  - Trademark sport logos (NFL, Jazz, University, etc.)
- Pediatric and NICU staff working in an adult/pediatric area must wear their assigned scrub color and no child-friendly scrub top.
  - Pediatric and NICU staff choosing to wear solid colors must wear their assigned scrub color.
