SAFE USE OF A PROCEDURE MASK OR FACE COVERING

Correct use of procedure masks and cloth face coverings help prevent the spread of viruses and disease and keep those around you safe and healthy.

Procedure Mask



A procedure mask will be provided to you if you have respiratory symptoms.

- Make sure the color side faces outward
- Wash your hands before putting it on

TO PUT ON

- Grab with the ear loops and place over your nose, mouth, and chin
- Gently press the metal wire along the upper edge of mask against the bride of your nose
- Wash your hands

TO REMOVE

- Wash your hands
- Remove the mask only using ear loops, pull away from your face
- Avoid touching the front when removing
- If reusing, store properly until you will use it again
- Discard if soiled or wet
- Wash your hands

Reusable Cloth Face Covering



A reusable cloth face covering will be provided to you if you do not have respiratory symptoms.

- Always use a clean face covering
- Wash your hands before putting it on

TO PUT ON

- Grab with the ear loops and make sure it covers your nose, mouth, and chin
- If the mask has ties, tie one around the crown of your head first, then tie the other around the back of your neck
- Wash your hands

TO REMOVE

- Wash your hands
- Remove the mask only using ear loops, pull away from your face
- If there are ties, undo the bottom tie first, then undo the top tie, lifting and pulling away from your face
- Avoid touching the front when removing
- Properly clean and store until you will use it again
- Wash your hands
