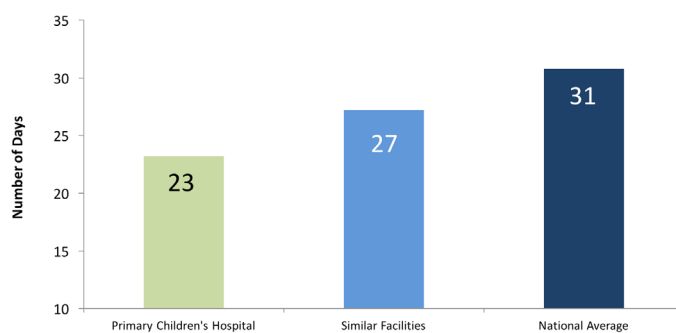


Research shows that early therapy intervention is important in recovery. Patients are admitted to our inpatient rehabilitation program much faster than the national average. Our unique program structure allows the rehabilitation team to begin collaboration with the medical team before a patient is admitted.

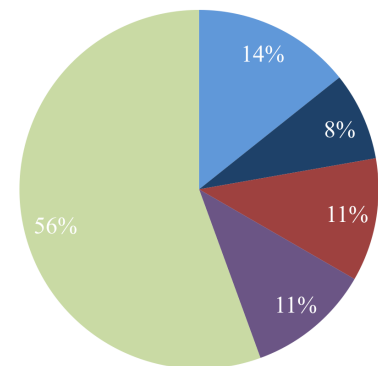

Fewer Days Waiting for Treatment is Better for Patients



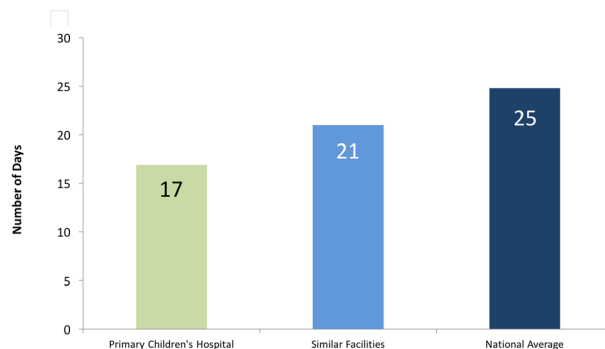
Ages of Patients

- Older than 10 Years

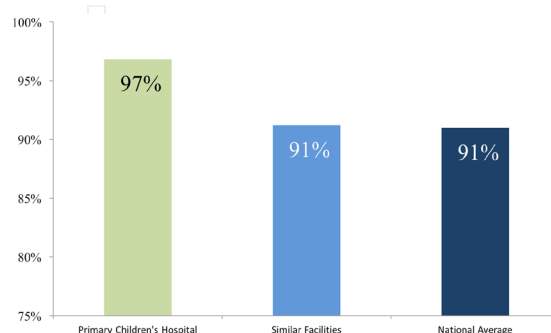
Average Days in Program

Fewer Days in the Hospital is Better for Patients & Families



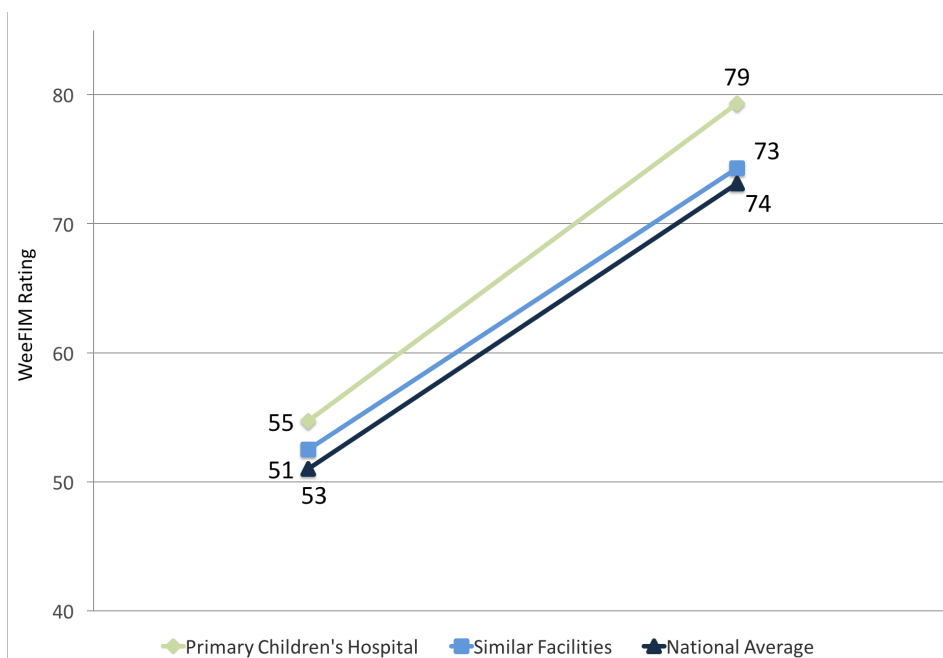
Patients Discharged to Home

Getting Families Back Home is Best for Everyone

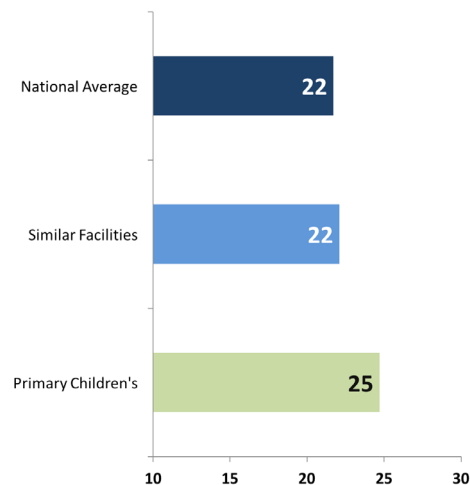
