



Nevada APP Fellowships At-a-Glance

- 12-month program in **Primary Care, Urgent Care, or Cardiology**
- Didactic lectures on various healthcare topics
- Rotations through multiple specialties (*varies by program*)
 - Cardiology
 - Endocrinology
 - Physical Medicine
 - Urgent Care
 - Oncology
 - Pulmonary
 - Behavioral Health
 - Dermatology
 - Inpatient/Post-acute
 - Women's Health
- Acclimate to the role of independent provider with mentor support
- Opportunity to attend workshops, bootcamps, and wellness events
- Excellent work-life balance (no call / no holidays)



Eligibility

- Graduate of a certified PA or NP program within the last 12 months
- Board certified as a PA/NP/AGNP/PMHNP (*or have exam scheduled*)
- Hold or apply for a valid, unencumbered NV license as a PA or NP
- Not be employed, or employed a max of 9 months, as an APP



Salary & Benefits

- Hired as a full-time APP with a competitive salary
- Sign-on bonus at 90-day mark
- Opportunity for incentive compensation after 90 days
- Full benefits package (medical, dental, PTO, etc.)
- 401K retirement
- CME funds and 80 hours of CME time off

Application Process

- Letter of good standing or grade transcript
- Two letters of reference
- Personal statement
- Curriculum vitae
- Headshot
- Brief 3-question video
