#### **OUR TEAM**

**Physicians,** board certified in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, and **Advanced Practice Providers** are highly trained to work in collaboration to provide advanced medical care

**Nursing staff,** including Certified Rehabilitation Registered Nurses, are specially trained in rehabilitation

Occupational therapists provide treatment to improve, regain and maintain the skills needed for self care, activities of daily living such as dressing, eating, bathing and problem solving

**Physical therapists** provide treatment to improve mobility, balance, coordination and strength

**Speech-language pathologists** provide treatment to improve communication, swallowing, and cognitive deficits

**Social Workers and Care Managers** coordinate care in the hospital, arrange care after discharge and provide counseling as needed

**Dietitians** ensure proper nutrition for healing

**Comprehensive medical specialists** provide resources for consultation, follow up and ongoing care

**Neuropsychologists** may provide specialized testing and other services for patients with neurological conditions.

### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Require daily physician care & 24-hour rehab nursing

Need at least two forms of therapy (physical, occupational and/or speech)

Be able to participate in three hours of therapy per day, five days per week

Have potential to improve physical & functional skills

#### WHAT TO BRING

Shorts or loose-fitting pants, T-shirts or blouses, sleepwear, walking shoes, a light jacket or sweater

Any personal items that will make your stay more comfortable, such as hygiene products, photographs, or a blanket

If you wear glasses, dentures, hearing aids or use a CPAP at home, please bring these with you


