RETIREE ANNUAL 2018 ENROLLMENT

Take a moment to see what's new for next year

Annual Enrollment is an important time to understand your benefit choices and to choose options that work best for you and your family in 2018.

Please review the enclosed materials to assist you with your benefit choices. Benefits changes must be made between October 30 and November 10, 2017.

BENEFIT CHANGES FOR 2018:

- **Dental Insurance:** Preventive care services will not count toward the annual maximum benefit in your plan, and you will see a decrease in your monthly premium.
- **Vision Plan:** This is a new benefit offered to retirees.

Dental Insurance

Beginning in 2018, you'll receive enhanced dental coverage for a lower premium and a new vision benefit option. As part of the enhanced coverage, preventive care services in our dental insurance plan will not count toward the annual maximum benefit. In the past, if you or a family member had some major dental work early in the year that used up most of your annual maximum benefit, you might have ended up paying out of pocket for some of your preventive care services. This change will ensure that you are covered for preventive dental care all year long.

Refer to the Annual Enrollment Quick Guide on the cover of this newsletter for enrollment and cancellation details. Please keep in mind that dental cancellations are always effective December 31 of the current year. You can only cancel or enroll in dental insurance during the annual enrollment period held from October 30 to November 10.

What's new for retirees? VASA Fitness Discount



TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE VASA FITNESS DISCOUNT. Intermountain Healthcare has partnered with VASA Fitness to provide significant discounts for employees, retirees and their immediate family members. The Intermountain discount rate is a flat monthly fee without any additional fees and includes access to all 20 VASA Fitness Centers in Utah.

The average rate for full-fledged VASA membership is \$24/month, but the Intermountain discount rate begins at \$15 (plus tax) and decreases as more Intermountain employees and family members sign up. Membership includes a first-time orientation and a complimentary fitness assessment.

HOW DO I SIGN UP? To sign up, go to **cwjoin.vasafitness.com** and enter

company code: Intermountain Retirees. Select a plan and fill out all the fields. Agree to the terms and click submit. Take your ID into any VASA Fitness to pick up your barcode.

WHAT IF I ALREADY HAVE A VASA MEMBERSHIP? If you currently have a VASA membership, first cancel your membership online at cancel.vasafitness. com (cancellation fee may apply) and then sign up online with the Intermountain discount.

WHAT DOES THE MEMBERSHIP INCLUDE? The membership includes fitness classes, machines with video screens, basketball, racquetball, cardio cinema, women's only section, hydro massage beds, steam room sauna, hot tub and pool.

Vision Plan

As a result of increased requests from our retirees, you now have the option to add our new vision plan option to your existing dental coverage, which will begin January 1, 2018.

According to the Vision Council of America, approximately 75% of adults use some sort of vision correction. And, as you get older, the likelihood of you needing some kind of vision correction hardware increases. As you consider your vision correction needs in 2018, take a minute to review the benefits that this new vision plan has to offer.

What does it cover? Vision benefits are designed to help reduce costs of eyeglasses, contact lenses, and other vision services. Refer to the enclosed Schedule of Benefits for details.

Our new vision plan does not include an eye exam. An annual eye exam may be covered through your

health insurance. Check with your health insurance provider for more information.

How to enroll

If you would like to enroll in our new vision plan, please complete the enclosed Dental & Vision Enrollment Form. Keep in mind that you must enroll in dental in order to be able to enroll in the vision plan.

The vision plan premiums are listed to the right. Vision cancellations are always effective December 31 of the current year. You can only cancel or enroll in vision insurance during the annual enrollment period held from October 30 to November 10.

Intermountain retiree finds silver lining amid life's challenges

If you ever decide to join a yoga class in Salt Lake City, you just might run into Intermountain Healthcare retiree, Nancy Adams. But you won't find her in the back of the class. You'll find her in the front—teaching everyone else.



Switching roles from Regional Director of Human Resources to Yoga Instructor, this 68-year-old is embracing her new life as a retiree and enjoying every minute of it (despite its unexpected twists and turns).

Six years ago, Nancy retired on the same day as her husband, Alfred, after working for 32 years at Intermountain Healthcare.

"My career was very fulfilling, but I don't miss nylons, high-heeled shoes, or coloring my hair! When I embraced my natural gray, it represented true freedom," Nancy says. "I have fond memories of my career, but I knew that retirement would be anything but boring."

However, just as Nancy and her husband began taking adventures

around the world—Costa Rica and Europe—he was diagnosed with cancer. "Eleven months later, my sweetheart died and I was alone," Nancy says.

Faced with the reality of her new situation, Nancy decided that good years were still ahead, they would just look differently than she had imagined. She continued to attend her Yoga classes and received an unexpected invitation to become a certified instructor herself. Hesitant at first, her instructor reassured her that she was indeed NOT too old.

"There was my miracle and 280 hours later, I became a Yoga instructor," Nancy recalls.

Nancy continued to redefine her life and rekindled her love of hiking. She found friends who enjoyed the same and together they hiked Angels Landing, Mount Baldy, and Wheeler Peak.

Her next big surprise came when she fell on the ice and broke both her wrists last December. Of course, she didn't let that get her down. She continued to teach her Yoga classes with her casts and an external fixator.

Today, Nancy continues to teach four Yoga classes per week and also enjoys spending time with her 96-year-old mother and her three children and five grandchildren.

"My future plans, without knowing what other big surprises await, are to remain curious, engaged, active, and invested in my students, family, and friends," Nancy says.
