STOP taking any of the TKI medicine listed below during the specified time frame **before any surgery.**

Common side effects of TKI medicine and treatment:

- Diarrhea: Take loperamide (Immodium), as needed.
- Metallic taste: Take zinc sulfate 50 mg, 3 times a day, as needed.
- Hand or foot rash: Be careful around hot water and try to prevent injury during the 1st month of taking TKIs. Use alcohol-free creams (Bag Balm, Eucerine, Udderly Smooth, or clobetasol.Wear thick padded socks or padded shoes.
- Nausea: Take ondansetron (Zofran), as needed.
- Fatigue: Exercise daily and follow the same sleep schedule.
- High blood pressure: Measure once a day. Follow your doctor's instructions
 if your blood pressure is too high or too low.
- Cardiac dysfunction: Get a TTE (a type of EKG) test to find out how well your heart is working, if you have risk factors.
