

VISITOR GUIDELINES

for COVID Patients COVID Recovered Family Members & Questionnaire

A patient admitted with COVID-19 may have a total of 2 family member visitors if the family members have proven recovery from COVID-19 within the last 90 days or a COVID vaccination. They may visit after coordinating with the patient's nurse & if they agree to wear the required personal protective equipment (PPE).



The nurse will ask the following questions to the potential visitor over the phone before the visitor is invited to the hospital:

- Y N **1.** Are you able to provide paper or electronic documentation with your name, date of birth, date of test, with proof of vaccination or positive PCR/Antigen test for COVID-19 within the last 90 days?
- Y N **2.** Were you hospitalized or did you require oxygen support when ill with COVID-19?
- Y N **3.** Do you have any immune-compromising conditions or take any medication to suppress the immune system? * (see second page for qualifying conditions)
- Y N **4.** Do you have any current symptoms of COVID-19 including headache, cough, fever, nausea, muscle aches, lack of taste/smell?
