Guidelines & Information

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Wear professional, clean, and appropriate attire. (no jeans, sandals, t-shirts, hats, etc) Visit the website for more information.
- Wear Festival of Trees I.D. during shift.
- Leave valuables and personal items at home. (Festival isn't responsible for lost/stolen items)
- Arrive early to find parking and check-in.
- Hosts for trees, wreaths, and other auctions check in at the hosting room - 200 C.
- If you are volunteering in a shop, and already have a host ticket, report directly to that area for instructions. If you do not have a host ticket, check in at room 200C.
- Take care of your area: engage attendees, pick up litter, ensure items aren't touched.
- On the back of each auction item is a story. Read the story and share it with visitors.
- If you need to leave your area for a break, make sure another host is there to cover for you.
- Shift ends when your replacement arrives.
