## PROCEDURE DOLL AND GOWN

This doll will be sent to hospitals for children who are undergoing surgery. Children will draw a face on the doll and mark where their surgery will be. Doll can be made out of sheet type fabric; preferably white, so the child can draw on the doll face.

## **DOLL**

- 1. Cut out pattern piece B, (leaving black outline on pattern). Fold B on fold line, tape or glue B to bottom of A at placement line.
- 2. (It may be easier to cut pattern out before placing on fabric.) Place pattern on fold of fabric and cut out two, one for the front and one for the back.
- 3. With right sides together using a ¼" inch seam, sew back and front together, leaving an opening as shown on pattern. Back stitch to secure seams.
- 4. Turn inside out and stuff with batting starting with head, legs, and arms. Stuff so doll is soft and squeezeable. Stuff body next.
- 5. Hand sew the opening securely, being careful to fold seams in the inside.

## <u>GOWN</u>

- 1. Select fabric with a "happy print" (small flowers or striped design) for boys as well as girls.
- 2. Each gown needs a piece of fabric measuring about 20" long and 16" wide
- 3. Use a thread color which blends with colors in fabric.
- 4. You will need a 24" piece of bias tape, twill tape or ribbon for the neck, and one set of round Velcro, (not adhesive Velcro. Velcro will need to be securely sewn).
- 5. Fold the piece of fabric in half evenly to measure 20" long and 8" wide
- 6. Line up pattern template on top of fabric with "front " on fold. Mark around and cut out.
- 7. Place pattern template for "Back" on fabric, mark and cut out two pieces.
- 8. Zig-zag or serge all raw edges.
- 9. Start to sew at shoulder, then hem sleeve. Sew sides together, hem bottom and back opening (start sewing from the bottom).
- 10. Sew bias tape, twill tape, or ribbon to wrong side of neck, then top stitch down on right side.
- 11. Sew circles of Velcro to close back.
- 12. Make bow and attach to neck.
- 13. Cut slit under both arms.
